FOOTBALL AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT Winter Football Academy

In February of 2010, C3F embarked on their first football training program. This 6 week football training academy was held at the Armory on Armory Drive in Franklin, Va. CEO, Greg Scott and Board Member Xavier Scott directed this program on Saturdays for 4 hours. The purpose of this Academy was to introduce C3F to the community, encourage physical activity and to promote the game of football, mentoring and motivating.

30 boys, ages 6-14, attended the Academy. Participants learned the fundamentals of football, engaged in footwork drills and played indoor flag football.

Spring Break Football Camp

In April, 2010, C3F introduced their first week-long football camp for young people in Franklin, VA. As a means to keep children involved in activities while school is out, C3F implemented its Spring Break Football Camp.

During this camp, 30 young men participated in football drills, skill development and outdoor flag football games. Again, CEO Greg Scott directed this camp with the help of his staff and Board Member Xavier Scott. Throughout the camp, Scott also installed wisdom and motivated through his "Rap Session". Through these sessions, Scott touched on the 3 Principals of Life; Hard Work, Commitment, and Positive Attitude.

Summer Football Camps

The 2010 Summer Camp Schedule began with the very first Cover 3 Football indoor skills camp held at the Fredericksburg Field House. 55 Children and 6 Staff participated in this great event. Throughout the summer Cover 3 Football held several other camps. Locations for camps included, Northampton County North Carolina, and Newport News Virginia and Franklin Virginia. Mornings at camp were dedicated to skill instruction. Campers enjoyed lunch and in the afternoons, campers enjoyed the thrill of competition in our flag football games.

On Fridays at summer camp, participants competed in a Cover 3 Football Flag Football Tournament. Winners and teams alike received coupons and gift certificates to Dick's Sporting Goods (sponsor).

MOTIVATING AND MENTORING Greg's Motivational Speeches and Appearances

In 2010, Founder and CEO Greg Scott decided that a sure way to reach out to the children of the communities we serve was to be face to face with them on a regular basis. One way he wanted to do this was through his Motivational Speaking Program. Mr. Scott visited several area schools, YMCA's, after school s programs and churches to deliver his message. Greg's communication of Hard Work, Commitment, and Positive Attitude coupled with stories of his playing days in the NFL proved to be a unique mixture worth the attention and excitement of all who listened.

Mr. Scott made several appearances throughout 2010. He spoke at Belfield Elementary in Emporia Virginia, Ruth Camp Campbell Library for Black History Month and he made appearances as a counselor and skill coach at the Mike Vick Summer Football Camp in Hampton Virginia and the Ray Bolton Football Combine in Virginia Beach.

C3'S KIDS MEALS

In September 2010, Cover 3 Football implemented C3's Kids Meals in order to provide mentoring and motivating through the service of meals and snacks to at-risk youth. Through the funding of USDA provided via the Virginia Department of Health, C3F began serving healthy and nutritious and snacks and meals to local at-risk after school programs, low-income daycares and community centers. By the end of 2010, C3F had completed their goal to feed 3,000 children every day in Southeastern Virginia.

Sites that were served in 2010 included Main Street Learning Center in Smithfield, East End Child Development Center in Suffolk, Capron Elementary, Meherrin Elementary, Emporia Family YMCA and James L Camp YMCA, Belfield Elementary and Wyatt Middle School.

Thanksgiving Turkey Giveaway

Thanksgiving brings an extra expense to families already in need. C3F assisted Lending a Helping Hand in 2010 with their Turkey Giveaway. C3F provided pre-boxed side dishes donated by Food Lion in Courtland, VA and Lending a Helping Hand provide the turkeys.

Competitive Flag Football Teams

As part of our community service, C3F football coaches and parents participated in supporting and teaching 5 flag football teams in Fredericksburg, VA. All teams competed in games held in a league at the Fredericksburg Field House. Coaches donated their time and efforts to coaching and mentoring these young men throughout the flag season. These players will be participating in our Competitive Tackle Teams in the fall of 2011.
